APFAN PT7 Proficiency Test to Improve Food Laboratory Analyses in the Asia Pacific Region

The holder of this food sample(s) is participating in a proficiency test (PT) organised by APFAN, the Asia Pacific Food Analysis Network, in association with Curtin University and the ChemCentre. The sample is of a Formulated Fish Food, presented as around 70g of pellets in a small white container. Its purpose is for laboratories in the Asia Pacific region to analyse to determine their analytical proficiency. It is to be analysed for nutrients and macro-metals.

These APFAN PT7 test materials are provided free of charge to all participants at a Workshop held in Perth, Western Australia, from 30th September to 2nd October 2026 and they have no commercial value. Since they are food samples, they contain no hazardous or illegal substances.
